NOTICE TO RCC FINANCIAL AID RECIPIENTS

CHILD CARE GRANT

If you are the parent of a child who will need child care so that you can attend a curriculum program at Randolph Community College during the 2009-2010 academic year, you may be eligible to receive a grant that will help cover the cost of your child care.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

Any student with a completed financial aid file at Randolph Community College is eligible to apply. Students must be enrolled in an RCC curriculum program. **Students who are enrolled exclusively in Continuing Education Programs are not eligible.** Because funds are limited, each year the College will select students according to the date of their application, the students current *Satisfactory Academic Progress*, and those with the greatest need as shown by financial aid records. Students who received these funds in the past must reapply in order to be ranked again but consideration to returning recipients will be given.

HOW DO I APPLY?

Interested students can pick up applications from the Financial Aid Office or Online. **Forms must be returned to the Financial Aid Office.**

WHAT ELSE DO I NEED TO KNOW?

- 1. Applying for the child care grant does not guarantee that you will be awarded.**
2. Students must complete their FAFSA application prior to applying for the child care grant.
3. Students must apply for child care assistance through DSS before being awarded the child care grant and will be required to provide proof from DSS that this has been completed.
- 4. Students will receive child care funds only to cover child care needs that correspond with the student's academic schedule. (*Example: students enrolled in a day program will not be allotted child care grant funds for child care during the evening.*)**
5. Payments from the grant are made directly to the care providers. Students assume responsibility for the validity of payment requests. Under the terms of the grant, no payment for care will be made in advance. .
6. Anyone who has an obligation to care for the child will not receive payment from this grant. A relative of the child may be the care provider, but a child's parent or stepparent will not be paid under this grant.
- 7. The contract for services is between the student and the provider.** The College makes no contract with the care providers.
