2010 Summer Session Application/Information Sheet

Deadlines: Early Registration- March 16, 2010; All Student Registration- April 13, 2010

If you intend to enroll in classes at Randolph Community College (RCC) during the 2010 Summer session and meet each of the eligibility requirements highlighted below, then please complete and return the 2010 Summer Session Financial Aid Application. By signing the application, you acknowledge that you have read and understand the information below.

Eligibility Requirements for Summer Session

In order to be eligible for Summer Session financial aid, you must:

- Have a valid 2009-2010 FAFSA on file at RCC
- Have submitted all required verification documents, if applicable.
- Be admitted to or enrolled in a degree, diploma, or eligible certificate program at RCC. Visiting/Special Credit students are not eligible to receive aid.
- Meet the requirements of the Satisfactory Academic Progress Policy for Financial Aid at the end of the Spring 2010 term (you may obtain a copy at http://www.randolph.edu/fin_aid/forms.php or by visiting the RCC Office of Financial Aid and Veterans Affairs).

Types of Aid Available

Pell Grant

If you meet the “Eligibility Requirements for Summer Session”, the Office of Financial Aid and Veterans Affairs will determine your Pell Grant eligibility.

Federal Work Study

Federal Work Study funds are available to eligible students during the Summer session. If you are not currently participating in the Federal Work Study program, please contact the RCC Office of Financial Aid and Veterans Affairs for more information.

Other Aid

If your award package includes the North Carolina Community College Grant, North Carolina Education Lottery Scholarship, North Carolina Student Incentive Grant; these funds are not available during Summer session.

The Office of Financial Aid and Veterans Affairs will review the student aid account for any other eligible remaining funds that may be used to assist the student. The Office of Financial Aid and Veterans Affairs will also search for additional funds not previously awarded that may help each student meet the costs to attend the Summer session. This does not mean that there are funds available, only that the RCC Office of Financial Aid and Veterans Affairs will actively search for financial opportunities for each student.
