



Compensatory Education Admissions Process

- 1) Meet with the Coordinator of Compensatory Education.
- 2) Complete an application packet.
- 3) Provide proof of eligibility. This condition must be determined and certified by a qualified professional, such as a physician, psychiatrist, psychologist, etc. This diagnosis must have been documented within the past ten years. Similarly, there must be appropriate documentation certifying the functioning level of individuals with brain damage/head injury.
- 4) Complete the CASAS pre-test.

Students will be notified by letter concerning eligibility within 5 business days of completion of the admissions process.
