The Adult High School Program is designed for students who lack a minimal number of credits to complete their high school diploma.

### **\*20 credits required to graduate:**

*\*The Adult High School Coordinator will evaluate your high school transcripts to determine the number of credits you will need to graduate from our program.*

### **\*Steps to Enter Adult High School Program:**

1. **TRANSCRIPT:** Get an official copy of your high school transcripts (sealed) and send to the Basic Skills Department. Transcripts may be mailed to:

2. **APPOINTMENT:** If you are under 18, you **MUST** schedule an appointment with the Dean of Basic Skills before entering the program. Call (336) 633-0106.
3. **ORIENTATION :** Complete *Connections*, the required 3-day orientation program. Call (336) 633-0106 to schedule your *Connections* appointment.
4. **PLACEMENT TEST:** During *Connections*, you will take a placement test in Math and Reading. Your score must indicate that you are at least a 9<sup>th</sup> grade level in math AND reading to enter the Adult High School program.
5. **ADVISING:** After taking the placement test you will meet with a counselor to determine your next step. If you do not achieve the required minimum score to enter the Adult High School program, you will be advised to attend Adult Basic Education (ABE) classes to improve your reading and/or math score.

#### **\*Graduation**

Adult High School students may elect to participate in the graduation ceremony which occurs at the end of each semester.
