Did you know? Randolph Community College's Career & College Promise (CCP) program allows high school sophomores, juniors, and seniors to take tuition-free college courses! Students who successfully complete their CCP courses may also earn both high school and college credit! Oh, and did we mention it's FREE?

Don't just take our word for it — Jerzie has the scoop!

My goal has always been to go straight to work after high school. CCP has made that happen for me. Not only can I go straight into the workforce with my welding diploma, but CCP was totally free!

Taking college classes while you're in high school is fun. You get free class periods, but you also get to learn things and gain real-world experience. While in the welding shop at RCC, it's hot, and you'll get burned a couple of times, but this all prepares you for when you go weld for businesses and companies. Once you get burned a couple of times, you'll figure out what you're doing wrong and fix it so you don't get burned again.

Career & College Promise offers students the option to choose from these pathways:

College Transfer

Designed for students planning to continue their education beyond high school to eventually achieve an associate or bachelor's degree at a community college or university. In North Carolina, there are 30 private universities and 16 public universities in our transfer agreements.

Career and College Ready

The CCP Career and College Ready Pathway will provide high school students with a unique opportunity for career exploration and college preparatory coursework. Facilitating a smooth transition to college or the workforce, upon completion of the required supplemental coursework, students may qualify for any approved Career and College Promise Pathway available at participating colleges.

Career & Technical Education

Allows students to begin a certificate or diploma program in a particular technical field or career area. Additionally, RCC collaborates with area four-year colleges and universities to offer courses in particular disciplines, creating an opportunity for students to complete a baccalaureate degree through special partnerships with local universities.

Continuing Education

Allows students to earn an employable credential in a specific technical field — whether it is helping people or pets or learning a building trade. These pathways do not earn college credit and the state currently waives tuition for public school students only.
