Randolph Community College Campus Impact Bylaws

Purpose/Mission

The Randolph Community College (RCC) Campus Impact Club gives students the opportunity to meet the needs of the campus and community through acts of service and good deeds. We intend to serve the faculty, students, staff and administration when they have a need that we can meet that will improve the quality of life on our campus and in the community.

Elections

All officers are elected by club members at the beginning of each fall semester. Members are defined as students conforming to stipulations in the "Rules" section below.

Officers

President: Runs club meetings, attends RCC Student Government Association (SGA) meetings, appoints committees, seeks grant funds

Vice President: Assists president in running club meetings, including filling for president during any absences from club meetings or SGA meetings; assists president in any duties needed.

Secretary: Records club meetings and handles club correspondence inside and outside of the college.

Treasurer: Collects and submits club fees to college; reports on fund balances to club; assists

Membership

- 1. Members are RCC students who have submitted a Campus Impact Club application.
- 2. Members are expected to participate in a majority of club activities during a semester.
- 3. Members are expected to show respect to all fellow members during meetings and projects.
- 4. Members that stop attending meetings or cause conflict may be dismissed from the club.
- 5. Club service projects are open to all RCC students but members of Campus Impact will lead all events.

Meetings

The RCC Campus Impact Club meets once a month and holds other service projects during the semester.

The club's goal is to do two service projects for the campus each semester. Meetings will be run by club officers according to Robert's Rules of Order.
