There is a 60-day waiting period after the second retake in a subject test (between every test after the third attempt).

- Receive two free retakes per module

You may only test three times in each subject within a calendar year. After you've tested three times, then you will have to wait to retest the next year.

Diploma Program

The student is required to demonstrate high school-level competencies in the five selected content areas:

- Mathematics
- Science
- Social Studies
- Technology

- Adult High School Courses
- High School Equivalency Assessments (GED/HiSET/STAC)
- BSP Transition Courses
- ★ Northstar Certification

Once a student has satisfactorily completed all requirements, a high school equivalency diploma will be awarded through the N.C. State Board of Community Colleges.
