



Curriculum Graduation Regalia Guidelines

Graduation regalia includes:

- The official Randolph Community College cap and gown.
- RCC approved academic honor stoles and cords.
- No additional decorations may be worn over the gown, but graduates may decorate graduation caps (mortarboard).

Suggestions for cap designs include:

- Leave it blank. Decoration of the graduation cap (mortarboard) is optional.
- Thank a parent, grandparent, teacher, guardian, friend.
- Recognize a program of study (e.g., Nursing, Photography, etc.) and/or year.
- Include an inspirational message.

Damaged caps will not be replaced. Graduates will not be able to participate in the ceremony without a cap and gown.

It is important that graduates comply with the RCC Student Conduct & Zero Tolerance policy and these Graduation Regalia Guidelines to avoid any type of disciplinary action. Failure to comply may result in not being allowed to participate in the ceremony, as well as documentation of the violation placed in the student record.
